**DAY 1: ORIGIN - MADRID**

Arrival to Madrid airport.  
You will be transferred to your hotel.  
**End of today program.** Check in and overnight.

**DAY 2: MADRID - TOLEDO - MADRID** B L

**DAY 3: MADRID - SEVILLE** B L  
(with AVE High Speed Train)

**Buffet breakfast.** Free time in the morning for Shopping or to explore Madrid. Lunch at local restaurant. After lunch, transfer to Madrid Atocha Train Station and take the AVE High Speed Train from Madrid to Seville ( 530 Km – 2.5 hrs ). Arrival, transfer to selected hotel and check in.

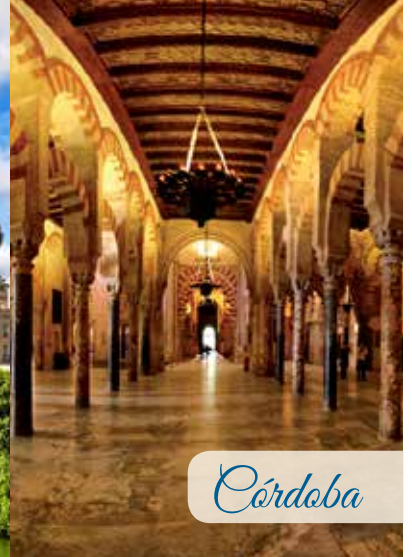
